This is the National Association of Nephrology Technicians/Technologists (NANT) annual educational event held in Las Vegas, NV. DTX is the premier meeting for nephrology clinical technicians and nephrology biomedical technologists. It is the ONLY program planned by technicians for technicians.

Sessions such as **Active Listening/How to Effectively Document** and **Having Difficult Conversations** will allow me to create solutions that positively impacts patient outcomes. I will have access to the PowerPoint presentations that I will share with our unit after I return from DTX, increasing the value of my attendance!

Additionally, DTX registration includes entrance to the Dialysis Solutions Center, the only exhibit area directly focused on products and services designed to help Nephrology Clinical Technicians/Nephrology Biomedical Technologists meet their clinic's needs.
