Sessions such **Infection Control and Prevention in the Dialysis Setting** and **KDOQI Life Plan and Access Guidelines that Impact Technicians** will allow me to create solutions that positively impact patient outcomes. I will have access to the PowerPoint presentations that I will share with our unit after DTX, increasing the value of my attendance!
